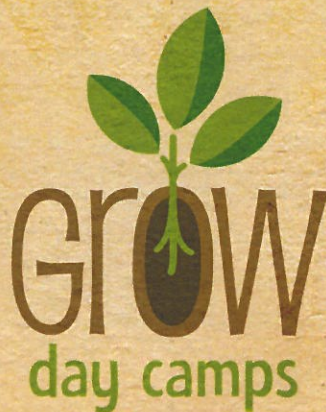

⛪ IS THERE A THEME? Grow is experiential faith formation. Campers experience the week in living groups of 3-10 campers and 2 counselors focused on building Christian community. Counselors plan each day's activities with the theme of the day and week in mind. Each summer's theme is based on professionally developed camp ministry curriculum that is age-appropriate, based on scripture, and respectful of God's creation.

⚡ DOES EVERYONE DO EVERYTHING? While most activities are open to all ages, only rising 5th-6th graders participate in belayed tree climbing (pending tree availability). Certain activities are also subject to weather conditions in order to ensure safety.

⚡ ARE ALL GROW SITES ALIKE? Each of our 32 sites is customized to its particular community, dates, rates, contact info, tree availability, and day trips vary by site.

ABOUT GROW

Grow brings the flavor of summer camp to local communities. Our mission is for each camper to grow deeper roots in their faith (grow spiritually), to grow in their ability to work as a team (grow socially), and to grow in self-confidence as a loved child of God (grow individually). Launched with a single site in 2008, Grow sets up camp at 32 sites per summer all over the North Georgia Conference. Archery, nature study, belayed tree climbing (when available) and time in worship outside are all core to the experience. Activities contribute to learning new skills, appreciating God's creation, building Christian community, and experiencing worship in new ways – all to support churches in nurturing Christian discipleship.

Each site is led by college-age site directors and by high-school-age counselors who have applied and interviewed for and been accepted to Grow's sibling ministry, the Experiential Leadership Institute (ngumc.org/eli). This on-site team is supported by a program director and director. Extensive staff training includes Safe Sanctuaries child safety policies as well as ropes course facilitation and First Aid/CPR training by professional vendors. As part of the North Georgia Camp & Retreat Ministries family, Grow is guided by philosophies and practices learned through 90+ years experience dating back to the founding of its sibling ministry, Glisson.
